Fundraising

<u>Cinnamon Roll Sunday:</u> Each month students are asked to bake Cinnamon Rolls for fellowship time. We need two families per month to do this. All the profits are pooled and then divided by the number of families who participated.

<u>Pizza Making:</u> We make take and bake pizzas. The profits from this event go to offset costs of the entire group, like transportation, food, the cost of chaperones etc.

Cookie Dough, Candles and Coffee Sales: Students may sign up to sell cookie dough, candles and coffee. All profits a youth makes directly lowers their individual costs.

<u>Service Hours</u>: Youth can do 10 hours of service and receive a \$50 service scholarship to attend the mission trip.

<u>Campership:</u> All students who sign up for the High School Mission Trip will receive a \$50 campership from the church (each youth only receives one per summer so if they are going to Riverside only one activity will be discounted.)
